BLUETOOTH USE & WARNINGS


- Bluetooth may cause radio interference do not use this device for critical life safety services.
- If call quality is poor, ensure the speaker is properly positioned at your ear and that your hand is not covering the microphone.
- Call quality may be affected by how you hold the device. For best results, hold it near the middle or bottom.
- Avoid placing obstacles (walls, furniture, etc.) between the PR200 and your phone.
- When pairing the PR200 with another device, stay close to ensure a stable connection.
- Do not use the device during thunderstorms.
- Turn off the device in areas where wireless use is restricted, such as hospitals or airplanes — it may interfere with medical or aviation
- In noisy or outdoor environments, background noise may affect call

BLUETOOTH NOTES

- The PR200 uses the same frequency as many common low-power wireless devices (e.g. Wi-Fi, medical, and scientific equipment). Interference may occur in crowded signal areas.
- Signal quality may drop near walls, corners, or partitions. For best performance, use the PR200 in open spaces.
- If your mobile phone is far from the PR200, call quality may decrease. When distance exceeds Bluetooth range, the call will automatically switch back to your phone.
- In loud environments, clear communication may be difficult due to ambient noise.

NOTE: If the PR200 is paired and powered on, all calls will be routed through the PR200 by default. To place a call using your phone instead, vou must disconnect Bluetooth from the PR200.

PR200 RECORDING GUIDE

The PR200 has three recording modes, controlled by the Recording Switch on the side of the device:

Switch	Function	Description
① VOICE	Voice Recording	For in-person or room audio recording
② OFF	■ Stop	Power off and stop all recording activity
③ MOBILE	Call Recording	For recording phone calls via Bluetooth

(IN-PERSON)

- Slide the Recording Switch to Position 1 - VOICE

The PR200 will begin capturing ambient or in-person conversations using its built-in microphone.



STOP RECORDING

- Slide the Recording Switch to Position 2 - OFF

This stops the current recording and powers off the device.




CALL RECORDING (BLUETOOTH)

■ Slide the Recording Switch to Position 🗿 – MOBILE

This enables phone call recording mode when your PR200 is paired via Bluetooth. Make sure the call is active and that you're speaking through the PR200.











The currently playing file will be permanently deleted.





- The PR200 has a built-in rechargeable battery.
- Charge it using a computer USB port or a standard AC/DC adapter
- The red LED will stay on while charging.
- When charging is complete, the red LED will blink
- A full charge takes approximately 2 hours.



BATTERY LEVEL CHECK

Check the battery level by briefly pressing the DEL button while the recorder is either: Playing/paused OR Recording

LED INDICATORS:

Battery Level	LED Signal
Sufficient	Green LED blinks 5 times
Normal	Blue LED blinks 5 times
Low (Under 30%)	Red LED blinks 5 times

▲ IMPORTANT NOTES:

- The battery level can only be checked when the recorder LED is on not during Bluetooth standby mode.
- If the battery is too low during recording or playback, the red LED will flash quickly, and the device will shut down.
- If the battery runs out during a Bluetooth call or call recording, a beep will sound, the call will switch back to your phone, and the recorder will shut off.

CONNECTING TO A PC CONNECTING TO A PC • Your recordings are saved in the VOICE folder as .MP3 files. • When you plug the Simply double-click a file in the VOICE folder to play it back using your computer's audio software. • You can delete files the same way you would delete

PR200 into your computer's USB port, it will appear as a Removable Disk (MemoQ).

File Name Auto-Sorting

• If you delete a file or unplug the device from your computer, the recorder will automatically re-sort and rename the files. During this process, the blue LED will **blink rapidly.** • If you have many recordings, this may take some time — please wait until the blinking

Set Time/Record Mode


 Connect the PR200 to your PC using the USB plug. 2 Open the "Time Setup" program located on the device (double-click it). 3 The date time.cfg Creator window will appear.

4 Click the Start button to create the PR200. The LED will blink rapidly — this confirms that the time setting



▲ IMPORTANT NOTES:

- The recorder will use your PC's date and time settings automatically.
- The exact time is recorded when you disconnect the device after clicking Start. • If the battery fully drains, the time will reset. Please run the time setup again
- before recording.



Use the volume buttons on the side of the device to increase or decrease the sound during playback or calls:

[+] Volume Up: Press briefly to raise the volume

[-] Volume Down: Press briefly to lower the volume

VOLUME NOTES

- You can adjust the volume while playing back recordings or during phone calls.
- Volume cannot be adjusted while the device is in standby mode.
- The volume range is from 0 (mute) to 10 (max) across 11 total steps.
- > The **ringer volume** for Bluetooth calls is also affected by this setting.

HOW TO USE BLUETOOTH (DETAILED GUIDE)

The Bluetooth function works independently — it can be used even when the recording switch is OFF.

TURNING BLUETOOTH ON/OFF

- Turn ON: Press and hold the Call button for about 2 seconds.
- → The blue light will blink twice, and you'll hear a beep.
- Turn OFF: Press and hold the Call button again for 2 seconds.
- → The blue light turns off, and you'll hear a beep.
- On first use, Bluetooth automatically enters pairing mode.

PAIRING WITH YOUR PHONE

- 1 Start with the PR200 powered off.
- 2 Press and hold the Call button for about 5 seconds until the blue and red lights flash alternately. This means it's in pairing mode.
- 3 On your phone, open **Bluetooth settings** and search for devices.
- 4 Select PR200 from the list.
- Once paired, the blue light on the PR200 will blink twice at regular intervals.

RELEASING THE CONNECTION

Option 1: Hold the Call button for 2 seconds to power off and disconnect. Option 2: Disconnect from your phone's Bluetooth menu.

To reconnect, either turn the PR200 back on or tap it from your phone's Bluetooth menu.

AUTO-RECONNECT & DISCONNECTION

- If you walk out of range, the light will blink once every few seconds.
- If no connection is re-established within 10 minutes, the device powers off to save battery.

TO RECONNECT:

- Come back into range within 10 minutes, or
- Tap the Call button once, or
- Turn the device off and back on.

RECEIVING A CALL

- When a call comes in, you'll hear a ringtone and the blue & red lights
- 2 Press the Call button once to answer.
- iPhone users can control Bluetooth call volume in their settings. Android volume is fixed by the system.

REJECTING OR ENDING CALLS

- Reject a call: Press the Call button twice quickly.
- End a call: Press the Call button once.

MAKING A CALL

The PR200 does not have a dial-out feature,

- Make the call from your phone.
- 2 The PR200 will act as your **Bluetooth headset** for the conversation.

ADJUSTING CALL VOLUME

While on a call, press the Volume + / - buttons on the side of the device to adjust the call volume.

HOW TO USE THE PR200 (DETAILED GUIDE)

GENERAL RECORDING

- Slide the Recording Switch to VOICE. The green indicator light will turn. on, and recording begins. 3 Each continuous recording is automatically split into 5-hour files. 4 If you stop recording within 3 seconds, the file is not saved.
- STOP RECORDING
- 1 Move the switch to OFF. 2 The current file is saved. & the device powers off.

∠ CALL RECORDING

Move the switch to MOBILE. 2 When you're on a call (incoming/outgoing) the PR200 starts recording **automatically**. **3** Recording stops as soon as the call ends. 4 The green light turns on during recording & turns off when finished.

IMPORTANT NOTES FOR CALL RECORDING:

Bluetooth must be paired for this to work. O Messenger or 3rd-party call apps (like WhatsApp, Zoom, etc.) may not be supported. If it doesn't work, switch to VOICE mode to record manually.

FILE & MEMORY LIMITS

- Up to 9,999 recordings can be saved.
- When memory is full or file limit is reached:
- The red light will blink rapidly; the device powers off automatically.

IDENTIFY AND SET OF THE POWER WITH EXTERNAL POWER

To extend your recording time beyond the built-in battery:

- Start recording in VOICE mode first Then connect the PR200 to an external power source (A PC USB port, An AC/DC adapter, or A portable USB battery pack)
- The recorder will continue recording while drawing power externally.
- 1 If you connect the device to power before switching to VOICE mode, recording won't begin until it's unplugged or fully charged.
- The built-in battery supports up to 16 hours of continuous recording on its own.

PLAYING BACK RECORDINGS

- Set the switch to OFF.
- 1 Press and hold the Play/Stop button for 3 seconds.
- The blue light turns on. Playback starts with your most recent file.
- 1 Use these buttons to navigate:
 - Previous: Skip back one file.
 - Next: Skip forward one file.
 - Hold Previous for 3 seconds: Go to the first recording.
 - D Hold Next for 3 seconds: Go to the last recording.
- Press Play/Stop again to pause playback.
- The red light turns on during pause.

AUTO POWER-OFF

If left on pause for 1 minute, the device will shut off to save battery.

(B) If a call comes in during playback, it will pause automatically.

TO DELETING A FILE

- **1** After stopping playback (red light is on), hold the **DEL** button for 3 seconds.
- A beep sounds. The current file plays for 10 seconds so you can review it.

- Press DEL again within the 10 seconds.
 A 2-second beep confirms the file was deleted.
- 3 To cancel deletion:
- Press any other button or let playback finish.
- ▲ DELETED FILES CAN'T BE RECOVERED. ALWAYS BACK UP IMPORTANT FILES TO YOUR PC BEFORE DELETING.

RESETTING THE DEVICE

If the device is unresponsive or the lights don't turn on during charging or PC

- Use a pen tip or paperclip to gently press the Reset Hole.
- This will restart the device and restore normal function.
- Saved recordings will not be erased during a reset.
